Dinesh is the founder & CEO of R.A.V.I.D. LLC a firm that is creating opportunities to contribute towards a quantum jump in the longevity and quality of life of all human beings. R.A.V.I.D. is a personalized AI enabled healthcare repository and collaborative solutions platform with a suite of digital and genomic analysis services to include a path towards SAFE AI.

R.A.V.I.D. enables anyone to integrate all their healthcare data to include Electronic Health Records, Wearables and/ or Real World Data along with insights from an individual's DNA and AI for their personalized benefit with AI anonymity on the cloud.

Dinesh is also the Founder & Managing Member of American Tiger LLC, a firm that has successfully incubated R.A.V.I.D. and provides a complete suite of back end software development services exclusively for R.A.V.I.D.LLC. Previously under a prior business model, the firm had pursued an investment strategy in identifying early stage innovation companies within the biotech sector that use Artificial Intelligence/ Machine Learning, to solve complex problems of life sciences to advance drug discovery for positive patient outcomes.

In 2023 Dinesh's efforts resulted in being one of two leading contender groups for licensing from OHSU Technology Transfer a portfolio of small molecules for a broad range of oncological targets for Clinical Trials.

Additionally in 2020 while in lockdown in Vietnam, Dinesh setup AT Saigon Advisors Company Limited to source and manufacture surgical Face Masks to help fight the infectious spread of Covid19 for charity. Dinesh lead all aspect of safety studies, machine design, manufacturing and quality control for this initiative.

Prior to 2020, Dinesh worked extensively on cross border investments across all asset classes in Mainland China & S.E. Asia via his participation at Morning Harbour Investment Advisors Limited (2006-2019) and Asian Tiger Advisors Limited (2014-2018), respectively, both Hong Kong based advisory services firms.

Additionally, from 1995 to 2001, Dinesh was one of the early entrepreneurs in the US that contributed to the commercialization of the Internet and in the mid-90's and served as the founder and CEO of Tribeca Internet Initiatives, Inc. where he built the world's largest India related online news and business portal.

Dinesh started his professional career as at a small New York City based broker dealer in 1987, where he was the firms Registered Option Principal. In 1989 he joined PaineWebber, Inc. a Wall Street firm where he helped in raising early stage capital for the Clinical trials of many first-generation biotechnology startups. Dinesh thereafter also initiated the firms India related investment banking initiatives in the early 1990's.

Additional Affiliations, Associations & Public Service

From 2002 to 2008 Dinesh served in various capacities at the University of Chicago, Booth School of Business (Chicago & Singapore campus) and at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign where he setup their Center for Entrepreneurial Development as a part of the Universities technology commercialization strategy. Subsequently was a Visiting Clinical Professor of International Business for their Executive MBA Program.

During 2005-2008 Dinesh was also an active TiE Charter Member from the Chicago & Singapore Chapters.

In 2015 Dinesh founded the *Myanmar Economic Forum (MEF)* in Burma that evolved from capacity development dialogues ranging from *Sovereign Ratings* to *Central Banking policies* to *Financial Sector Reform* to *Empowering Women Leadership in Economic Policy* to *advocating for Anti-Money Laundering Compliance* directly with military junta to combat *illicit* drugs manufacturing activities. Additionally, in 2017 under Dinesh's leadership MEF brought together international stakeholder to discuss '*The economic cost of Rakhine*' that contributed towards ending the genocide of ethnic Rohingya Muslims in Rakhine, Burma.

In 2017 Dinesh launched the *Asian Economic Forum (AEF)*, a public policy think tank, whose goals were to advance American thought leadership in S.E. Asia. In 2018, in the face of growing US-China trade tensions Dinesh conceived the *Indo-Pacific Dialogue* to bring together a number of diverse stakeholders for economic public policy discussions in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. In 2019, Dinesh also launched the *Nineteenth Amendment Annual Lecture* supporting *Women's Right Educational Equality and Economic Policy Leadership*.

In 2019 Dinesh helped organize *AEF* as a non-profit with a small presence in Washington D.C. Subsequently Dinesh published numerous Policy Papers advancing US interests regionally in the Indo-Pacific and S.E. Asia.

Dinesh is a US citizen and has an MBA from the Stern School of Business, New York University.
